RE: Lincoln County Food Service Sanitation Regulations

Dear Lincoln County Temporary Food Vendor:

On October 18, 2011, the Lincoln County Commissioner's signed into law a revision to the Lincoln County Food Service Sanitation Regulations Ordinance 3-23-1998. On January 1, 2012, all temporary food events will be required to abide by the revised Lincoln County Food Service Sanitation Regulations Ordinance 10-18-2011. This letter is informing you of this change.

The Lincoln County Health Department will be holding an informational meeting on November 7th and November 17th at 6:00pm in the Conference Room. It is highly encouraged for you to attend and clarify any questions you may have. The Lincoln County Food Service Sanitation Regulations was updated from the 1997 FDA Food Code to the 2009 FDA Food Code with the addition to Chapter 9: *Permits, Fees and Exemptions*. A copy of Chapter 9 is enclosed for your review. This update allows Lincoln County to be current with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. A copy of the Lincoln County Food Service Sanitation Regulations will be available for purchase in December for a charge of \$20.00.

Please contact our office with any questions and or concerns you may have regarding this change in the Food Code. I look forward to working with you.
